Sailing Instructions

Rules

The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*.

Entries

The regatta is open to all boats of the MC and M15 classes. Entries must be completed and all fees paid, in person or online, by close of registration: 9:00 am, September 24 2022.


Notices to competitors will be posted on the Official Notice Board located at the LHYC shed (Regatta Headquarters).

Signals Made Ashore


Signals made ashore will be displayed from the mast on the committee boat. If a postponement is signaled ashore, the warning signal will be made at least 30 minutes after flag AP is lowered.

Courses, Marks, Starting, and Finishing

Windward/Leeward courses with downwind-dogleg or upwind finishes. We expect to sail LAD 2 or 3 for back to back races, and WA 3 or 4 for the last race of each day. This will be designated on the committee boat course board. Marks will be orange or yellow. Starting and finishing lines will be between the committee boat mast (orange flag for start, blue for finish) and a buoy. Class flags display the M15 and MC class logos. The starting order will be announced at the competitors briefing. RRS 26 (5-minute sequence) will be used. General recalls are “rolling.” That is, the second fleet starts 5 minutes after the recalled fleet, and the recalled fleet starts 5 minutes after all scheduled starts have been completed.

Time Limit

The time limit for each race will be 1 hour for the first boat to finish.

Crew

It is allowed to change skippers and crew throughout the weekend. Each boat will be scored by its sail number.

Protests

Protests shall be delivered to Regatta Headquarters within 30 minutes after the committee boat docks. The protest time limit and a list of protests received will be posted on the notice board. Hearings will be held as soon as practicable after racing each day at Regatta Headquarters.

Radio

The Race Committee will make courtesy announcements on VHF Channel 72. Individual recalls will be hailed first via radio.

Scoring

The Low Point System, RRS A4, will apply. There will be one throw out after 6 completed races. One race constitutes a regatta for purposes of awarding trophies.
